

## About Instructor: Dr. QC Zhang

- Upon graduating from Shanghai Second Medical University in 1962, Dr. Zhang worked as a physician at Reijing Hospital in Shanghai. He also conducted clinical research on the integration of Chinese and Western medicine.
- In 1980, he was awarded a World Health Organization scholarship that supported a two year fellowship at Harvard Medical School and Massachusetts General Hospital. In 1984 he worked as research fellow at the Wakai Clinic in Nagoya, Japan. He then received a one year appointment from the University of California at Davis as visiting professor.
- Beginning in 1986, Dr. Zhang was the primary researcher at the Oriental Healing Arts Institute, where he conducted research on treating AIDS with Chinese medicine.
- He started his private practice in 1990 and is the founder of Zhang's Clinic in New York City. Since then, his focus has been viral hepatitis, AIDS, Lyme disease and autoimmune disease.
- Dr. Andrew Weil has referred him twice in his Newsletter "Self Healing" in 1998 and 2002. Dr. Weil has also referred him on the nationwide interviews at Larry King (CNN) talk show.
- He has given presentation on "Healing Hepatitis C with Modern Chinese Medicine" to the fellows of Program in Integrative Medicine in the University of Arizona at Tucson.
- He was in the faculty/guest speaker list of The First Winter Institute in Tropical Medicine and Public Health, January 8-19, 2001, Held by the Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health and The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. His topics were "Healing Hepatitis C and Lyme Disease with Modern Chinese Medicine". He has given talks of same topic to The Center for the Study of Hepatitis C of Cornell University and New York Presbyterian Hospital in May 2001.
- He has been given talks to numerous seminars in California, Oregon, New York, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Arizona, and Maryland.
- He has given presentations to The Morris Center of Education at Bridgehampton, NY on May 21<sup>st</sup> 2004, and Portland Oregon on September 11, 2004, on October 6, 2004 presentation at Kingston Hospital in Kingston NY.
- He has treated more than 2000 hepatitis C patients in his clinic in New York City and more than 3000 hepatitis C patients have used his protocols. Majority of them got very positive results.
